Guadalaxara (*gwah-dah-lah-hah'rah*)? Mazatlan (*mahz-at-lahn*)? Durango? Guaymas (*gwah'mahs*)? Belize (*be-leez*)? Guatemala (*gau-te-mah'-la*)? San Salvador? Comayagua (*ko-mi-ah'gwah*)? Truxillo (*troo-heel'yo*)? Leon (*la-ōne*)? San Jose?

Remember that *a* in Mexican names has generally the sound of *ah*, and that *g* has scarcely any sound; hence Guadalaxara is pronounced almost *gwah-dah-lah-hah'rah*.
