COUNTRIES.

Questions.—Where is it situated? How is it bounded?

EXAMPLE.—Egypt?—Situated in the northeast part of Africa; bounded on the north by the Mediterranean Sea; east by the Red Sea; south by Nubia; and west by the Libyan Desert.
